If WCG's rate request is approved by the CPUC, the average residential monthly bill would decrease by approximately \$0.37 or \$4.44 per year in 2022-2024.

HOW DOES THE REST OF THE PROCESS WORK? This application has been assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider the proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.
