**Subject: General Order (G.O.) 112-F Compliance Inspection of San Diego Gas and Electric Company's Emergency Response Program**

Dear Mr. Schwecke:

The Safety Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission conducted a G.O. 112-F inspection of San Diego Gas and Electric Company's (SDG&E) Emergency Response Program on September 14-18, 2020. The inspection included a review of SDG&E's records from calendar years 2016 to 2019. SED used the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety's "Inspection Assistant Form" as a reference guide to conduct the inspection. SED reviewed records remotely during this inspection due to COVID-19 and California Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-33-20 ("Safer at Home, Stay at Home"), shelter in place, and social distancing guidelines.

SED staff found no probable violations or concerns during its inspection and considers this inspection closed.
