Pursuant to Senate Bill 350 (de León, Chapter 547, Statutes of 2015), the CEC and the CPUC have established the Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group. The advisory group advises the two commissions on the effectiveness of proposed programs related to the Clean Energy and Pollution Reduction Act of 2015 (also known as Senate Bill 350) in disadvantaged communities.

Commissioners from the CEC and the CPUC may also attend and participate in the meeting, but no votes by the commissioners will be taken.
