Pursuant to Public Utilities Commission Decision D.19-06-033

- Beginning on July 1, 2019, transportation network companies (TNCs) are required to collect a ten cent (\$0.10) fee on each TNC trip in California to support the expansion of on-demand transportation for non-folding wheelchair users who require a wheelchair accessible vehicle (WAV).
- The "TNC Access for All Fund Fee" is required to be collected on each "TNC trip" only. A "TNC trip" refers to a trip completed 1) under a TNC's operating authority 2) using a TNC's online-enabled application or platform to connect passengers with drivers using their personal vehicles. The fee is not required to be collected on trips provided by transportation charter party (TCP) carriers, rather than by drivers using their personal vehicles, that may be available for chartering on a TNC's app.
- Each <u>county</u> in California is designated as a distinct "geographic area" for purposes of Access for All Fund fee collection, reporting, and remittance. The fee is collected from the county where the TNC trip originates.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Commission Decision D.21-11-004 Ordering Paragraph 4

Each TNC shall provide a list of counties in which it operated WAV service for a given quarter, whether or not it seeks an offset in that geographic area. This is effective beginning the Fee Statement for the 2nd Quarter of 2022.
