Background:

Rulemaking 19-09-009 facilitates the commercialization and deployment of microgrids while prioritizing system, public, and worker safety and avoiding shifting costs between ratepayers. On September 12, 2019, the Commission initiated this Rulemaking to design a framework surrounding the commercialization of microgrids associated with Senate Bill (SB) 1339 (Stern, 2018), as well as to account for the Commission's commitment toward utilizing additional technologies, tools and activities that may be useful for achieving overall resiliency goals.

On December 17, 2021, the assigned Commissioner issued an <u>Amended Scoping Memo and Ruling</u> for Track 4 and Track 5 of this proceeding. This Amended Scoping Memo and Ruling continued to set parameters for implementing SB 1339 microgrid programs, including assessing the value of resiliency to inform investments in resiliency strategies. As part of the effort, the CPUC is holding

workshops to explore topics previously identified in the Resiliency and Microgrids Working Group meetings as those that need more in-depth discussion and consideration. The topics may be subject to change and reprioritized as the discussions evolve over the course of the series of workshops.

Purpose of the Meeting:

This is the third workshop in a series exploring the topic of the Value of Resiliency in the Microgrids proceeding (R.19-09-009). This workshop will focus on "Resiliency Standards - Definitions". Lumen Energy Strategy, a CEC EPIC awardee working on building a resiliency framework, will be presenting and facilitating discussions exploring resiliency definitions and how these definitions may be applied to integrating resiliency in a broader grid planning perspective by applying the concepts to the current Integrative Resource Planning (IRP) process. This workshop is intended to deepen stakeholder's education, knowledge, and inquiry about the topic, as well as to provide them an opportunity to ask questions and provide input.
