On April 19, 2011, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) submitted a Notice of Proposed Construction (NPC) to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) seeking authority to begin construction of all "indoor" construction activities within the Valley, Elsinore, and Ivyglen Substations, as described in the Final Environmental Impact Report. The NPC requests the CPUC to act upon SCE's request for the authority to proceed with the construction of this segment of the project. .

A Final Environmental Impact Report (SCH # 2008011082) for the project was published in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act by the CPUC in May 2010. On August 12, 2010, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was granted by the CPUC under Decision 10-08-009.

Notice To Proceed #2 is granted by the CPUC for the construction activities describe in SCE's Notice of Proposed Construction dated April 19, 2011.
