The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) will jointly convene the first meeting of the Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group. The Advisory Group will advise the two commissions regarding the development, implementation, and impacts of proposed programs related to the Clean Energy and Pollution Reduction Act of 2015 (also known as Senate Bill 350) in disadvantaged communities.
