Notice of Additional Item to be Considered Pursuant to Government Code § 11125.3

Pursuant to Government Code section 11125.3, the DACAG may discuss CPUC proceeding R.15-03-010, examining affordable energy options in San Joaquin Valley communities, and may vote on the submission of comments related to a Bill Protection Workshop scheduled for February 1, 2019. The workshop was announced on January 17, 2019, after the agenda to this meeting was posted.

This item will be considered by the DACAG only if it makes the determinations required by Government Code section 11125.3(a)(2).
