## Background: SB 350

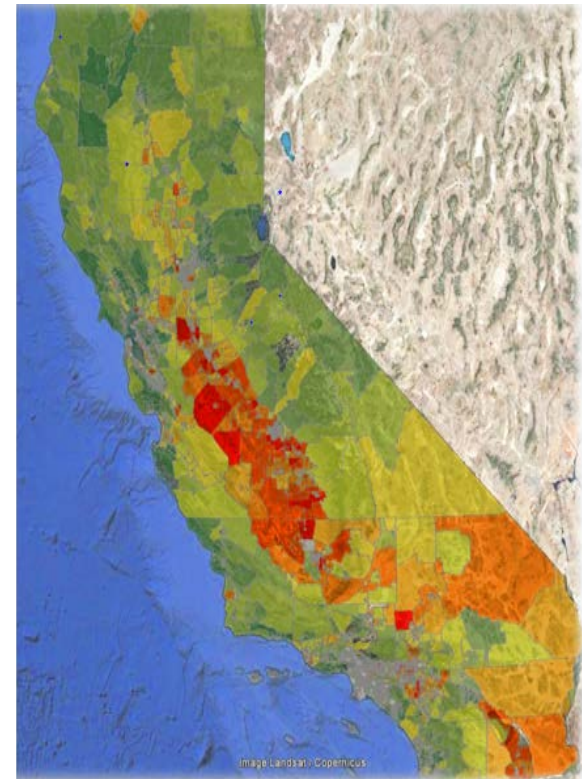
- SB 350 seeks to reduce GHG emissions from 1990 levels 40% by 2030, and reduce other air pollutants, through:
  - Increasing **Renewable Requirements** from 33% by 2020 to **50% by 2030**
  - **Doubling of Energy Efficiency savings** from electricity and natural gas end-uses by 2030
  - Encouraging **transportation electrification to reduce economy wide GHGs**
  - **Transforming the CAISO to a regional organization** that would include other western states





# SB 350: Priority on Disadvantaged Communities

- Requirements of SB 350
  - Consider impacts on Disadvantaged Communities in CPUC decision making processes
  - Improve access to programs in Disadvantaged Communities
  - Prioritize air quality improvements
  - Target economic benefits
  - Create a Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group





# Advisory Group's SB 350 Duties

- Article 4 of Charter requires that A G:
  - Identify priority programs or subject areas which impact disadvantaged communities
  - Advise on potential benefits and impacts related to design and implementation of Clean Energy programs
  - Advise on measuring program effectiveness
