Assembly Bill (AB) 1070 (Stats. 2017, Ch. 662) directs the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to develop standardized inputs and assumptions to be used in the calculation and presentation of electric utility bill savings to a consumer that can be expected by using a solar energy system by vendors, installers, or financing entities and to post them on its Internet Web site.

In accordance with AB 1070, the Commission's Energy Division staff has developed a proposal for standardized inputs and assumptions for calculating electric utility bill savings from the use of a solar energy system. The primary goal of this workshop is to build understanding of the elements in the staff proposal so that submitted comments are as informed as possible.
