Liberty Utility Advice Letters - The CPUC approved Liberty Advice Letter (AL) 180-E, authorizing Liberty to update the components in its Public Purpose Program ("PPP") surcharge for its California Alternative Rates for Energy ("CARE") program and the Energy Saving Assistance ("ESA") program, pursuant to Decision No. (D.) 21-10-023 and D.14-05-004. Liberty electric rates will change on January 1, 2022, as detailed in the table below.
