October 2022 ENERGY DIVISION RATE CHANGE ADVISORY

Liberty Utility Advice Letters – The CPUC approved Liberty Advice Letter (AL) 197-E, authorizing Liberty to update its Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC) rates for fuel and purchased power costs as well California Climate Credit payments, pursuant to Decision No. (D.) 22-09-013. Liberty electric rates will change on October 1, 2022, as detailed in the table below.
