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PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION REPORT PURSUANT TO PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 910.1

Introduction

Pub. Util. Code Section 910.1 requires that the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) report on the number of formal proceedings where resolution exceeded the time periods prescribed in scoping memos and the number of days that Commissioners presided in hearings. It further requires that the Commission submit the report to the Governor and Legislature no later than February 1 of each year. As described in this report for calendar year 2016, all proceedings resolved at the Commission during 2016 that were subject to statutory deadlines were completed consistent with statutory timeframes, either due to resolution within the statutory deadlines or because a scoping memo establishing a longer deadline or timely extension order was issued as permitted by law. This report provides details regarding whether proceedings were resolved in a timely manner with or without extension orders. More detailed information is contained in the attached Appendices A-K.

Pub. Util. Code Sections 1701.1 et al. apply to cases filed after 1998 that were subject to hearing at the Commission. These statutes require that matters be resolved within certain time periods, depending on the categorization of a proceeding. Generally, adjudicatory matters must be resolved within 12 months and ratesetting and quasi-legislative matters are to be resolved within 18 months of the issuance of the scoping memo ruling, unless a longer deadline is set by the CPUC through issuance of a scoping memo or order extending the statutory time period. A proceeding has been resolved when the main issues have been decided such that the proceeding could usually be closed. At times, proceedings that have had all substantive issues decided may remain open or are "re-opened" because of other issues, such as petitions for modifications, various motions, or requests for intervenor compensation.

² Effective January 1, 2017, ratesetting and guasi-legislative matters are to be resolved within 18 months from initiation.

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In addition to data related to proceedings that were subject to hearings and statutory deadlines, this report contains important case management information on other proceedings as well, in the interest of providing transparency, public access, and statutory compliance.

Description of Attached Appendices A-K

<u>Appendix A – Formal Proceedings not Subject to Hearings, Active During this Reporting Period</u>

Appendix A lists the 280 cases active during the time period that were not subject to hearings. This year many of these proceedings are ratesetting or adjudicatory matters that were conducted without formal evidentiary hearings. Also, this appendix lists 30 quasi-legislative matters that were processed through the exchange of written documents and formal evidentiary hearings were not required.

These proceedings are not subject to statutory deadline. Of the 280 cases, 189 were resolved in a time consistent with the deadlines set by the CPUC in scoping memos. The remaining 81 proceedings are currently active and on schedule.

<u>Appendix B – Complaints Under the Expedited Complaint Procedure, Active During the Reporting Period</u>

Appendix B lists 38 Expedited Complaint Proceedings (ECP) that are small complaint cases handled under special procedures analogous to "small claims" court. These proceedings are not subject to statutory deadlines. We are reporting these matters separately because the Commission has adopted more aggressive timelines for these cases than the statutory timelines for other proceedings. The Commission has established an informal 132-day target for this type of proceeding to be resolved.

During the reporting period, 33 of these 38 cases were resolved. Five proceedings remain active.

<u>Appendix C – Formal Proceedings Subject to Hearings, Active During the Reporting Period Proceedings Resolved on Schedule</u>

During the reporting period, the Commission timely resolved 42 (37 ratesetting and 5 adjudicatory) proceedings subject to evidentiary hearings.

<u>Appendix D – Formal Proceedings Subject to Hearing, Currently Active and on Schedule</u>

Appendix D contains cases subject to hearing that are not yet resolved and currently still active. There are 118 such cases – 27 adjudicatory, 5 quasi-legislative, 1 quasi-legislative/adjudicatory, 4 quasi-legislative/ratesetting, and 81 ratesetting. All of these cases are currently on schedule taking into account statutory deadlines, orders extending statutory timeframes, and scoping memos establishing deadlines that in some instances exceed statutory timeframes.

Appendix E – Petitions for Rulemaking

Petitions for Rulemaking are statutorily mandated proceedings subject to the deadlines in Pub. Util. Code Section 1708.5. The Commission is mandated to issue a decision in this type of proceeding within six months. Appendix E shows that four such proceedings were active during the reporting period and that the Commission has issued two timely decisions. Two petitions are active and currently on schedule.

Appendix F – Citation Appeals and General Order 156 Appeals

The Commission, in Resolution ALJ-299, signed on June 26, 2014, established a Pilot Program Citation Appeal and General Order 156 Appellate Rules, effective January 1, 2015. Under this pilot program, these appellate records will be easily accessible, thus enhancing due process in these expeditious proceedings. Appendix F shows that thirteen such appeals were active during the reporting period and that the Commission has issued nine resolutions addressing the appeals. Four appeals are active.

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Appendix G – Citation Appeals and General Order 156 Appeals

The Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 created a new type of proceeding with aggressive timelines. These proceedings are not subject to the SB 960 timelines. During the reporting period two of these proceedings were active at the Commission. The Commission has issued two decisions within the federally mandated 9-month timeline.

Appendix H - Commissioner Attendance

Appendix H reports the Commissioner attendance at hearings during the period. The table shows that Commissioners attended 83 days of hearings and presided during 27 of those 83 days.

Appendix I – 60-90 Day Compliance

The Legislature has also established guidelines for the length of time between the issuance of a proposed decision and the adoption of a final decision by the Commission, applicable to ratesetting and quasi-legislative proceedings requiring a hearing. The guidelines are either 60 or 90 days depending on certain circumstances.

During the period, the Commission considered 36 proposed decisions in proceedings subject to these guidelines. The Commission adopted 35 final decisions in such proceedings. In 30 instances, the final decision was adopted within the guidelines and in five instances; the final decision was issued later than the period specified in the guidelines. One proposed decision was withdrawn.

<u>Appendix J – Issuance of Presiding Officer Decisions and Proposed Decisions</u>

For proceedings that require a hearing, the Legislature has also established guidelines for the length of time between the submission of a matter for decision and the issuance of the proposed decision. During the period, the Commission issued one presiding officer decisions and 31 proposed decisions in such proceedings. Out of these 32 decisions, 20 (62.5%) were issued within the mandatory 60-day and 90-day timelines. This percentage is higher than 2015 by 4.5% despite the Administrative Law Judges Division experiencing significant turnover during the past year. During 2016, the Administrative Law Judges Division hired four new full-time judges, who are in the process of being trained. At the same time, the Division lost five judges due to retirements and new job opportunities. Despite these challenging staffing issues, we are looking at ways to achieve better results in 2017.

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Appendix K – Issuance of Extension Orders

The Legislature has also established a process for extending the statutory deadlines through issuance of an extension order. During 2016, the Commission issued 34 extension orders in 20 separate proceedings (more than one extension order was issued in some proceedings), including proceedings which remained open at the end of 2016. Of the 287 proceedings resolved in 2016, 42 proceedings were subject to statutory deadlines and there were 13 proceedings where extension orders were issued.

Conclusion

In summary, this report, submitted in compliance with Pub. Util. Code Section 910.1, provides the public and the legislature information on Commission action in formal proceedings. Specifically, 497 proceedings were active at the Commission during the 2016 reporting period. 287 of these proceedings were resolved during 2016. 42 of the proceedings that were resolved were subject to statutory deadlines. 100% of the proceedings subject to statutory deadlines were resolved consistent with statutory requirements taking into account scoping memos, which in some instances set deadlines longer than statutory timeframes, and orders extending the statutory timeframes adopted by the Commission, as permitted by statute. The Commission is committed to continuing to achieve full compliance with the mandatory statutory deadlines, transparent and accessible proceedings and procedures, and will work toward compliance with the statutory guidelines.
