### Purpose and Scope

#### Establish a policy that articulates a vision and provides guidance for **CPUC's compliance and enforcement activities**

CPUC enforcement programs should promote compliance with Commission rules. Achieving this goal requires us to review and strengthen our current programs in a number of ways, including the following:

- Ensure that instances of noncompliance are met with swift, certain and consistent responses
- Establish more uniform policies to guide the exercise of Commission's enforcement discretion
- Identify gaps in administrative tools and authorities & assess resource needs
- Prioritize enforcement efforts in areas of greatest threat to public safety
- Ensure that noncompliance incidents are consistently documented and made publicly available

#### **ACTIONS TO DATE**

- Documented existing policies and practice with each division
- Compiled table of citation authorities with brief descriptions and links to electronic documents
- Documented the different databases used by the divisions to track enforcement activities
- Drafted set of enforcement principles

- Learn from internal and external experts
- Develop enforcement policy and guidance
- Create enforcement webpage publicizing CPUC enforcement tools & actions
- Develop systems and centralized database for reporting, tracking, managing, and archiving
